Following her success in securing an apprenticeship here at UHP we were keen to shout about Sapphire's journey and how she was able to use valuable knowledge gained during a work experience placement in Neurophysiology to begin the career she had dreamed of. Nicola Broomfield, Clinical Scientist/Service Lead, and Sapphire Langdon, Apprentice share how work experience placements, can lead to great opportunities.

#### Nicola, why did you decide to provide a work experience opportunity within your department?

We decided to offer work experience after a successful Trust open day that attracted interest from a number of school leavers. We find recruitment difficult in the south-west and tend to need to 'grow our own' future workforce. The apprenticeship model is new to us but I think it will meet our needs well.

### Sapphire, what made you want to apply for work experience and how did you apply?

"I initially applied for the work experience as it looked like the perfect match to my interests in Psychology and Biology as Neurophysiology holds many aspects of both subject areas and seemed like a very exciting opportunity to see my biological interests in action"

I was given contact details for the department which I obtained at a careers day at the hospital. I then emailed Nikki and expressed my interests. She swiftly responded with the required health and safety and work experience forms.



Nicola, how did the work experience opportunity help Sapphire when applying for the apprenticeship opportunity within your department?

Work experienced gave Sapphire an opportunity to see what working in neurophysiology and the wider hospital environment is like. It is important to know what both the possible future experience of university and the work place is like (both for the candidate and the department)
